We had more than 15” of rain overnight on Aug 4th which caused extensive flooding, mostly cars and in garages. Assessments are being made to prevent future flooding.

A big thank you to **Nicole at Sunstate** for the emails and to residents for Facebook posts that kept us updated and informed during the flood.

Tennis Courts, Rec Center Pool are now open, but the Clubhouse pool needs to be resurfaced.

The Clubhouse did not lose power and was open for people to charge phones, fix a meal, or just get out of the heat.

FPL Update – We are on separate power lines and while the clubhouse and condo had power, some residents were out for days, especially in the back that has above ground power lines through the trees and had flooded transformers.

Thank you, David Kis, for working tirelessly to restore power then and to reduce future outages:

- Cleared growth from all lines and remove trees as needed,
- Add another pole in the trees to increase stability
- Raise concrete bases on 9 transformers to 24”
- Proposal to run 2 lines under - ground before next season.

If you lose electricity in your home, the Clubhouse may still have power and a/c.
